Ruth Stutz Succumbs

THE EAGLE RIVER SCHOOL WAS ADVISED THIS WEEK OF THE DEATH OF MISS RUTH STUTZ WHO TAUGHT THE MORNING SHIFT SIXTH GRADE THIS FALL UNTIL SHE BECAME SERIOUSLY ILL SEVERAL WEEKS AGO AND WAS FLOWN TO DENVER, COLO. ACCOMPANYING RUTH ON THE TRIP WAS MRS. DOROTHY ERICKSON, EAGLE RIVER SECOND GRADE TEACHER. RUTH'S PARENTS, MR AND MRS. F.W. STUTZ, MET HER AT THE DENVER AIRPORT AND THE YOUNG SCHOOL TEACHER WAS ADMITTED TO A HOSPITAL NEAR HER HOME IN NEBRASKA. RUTH PASSED AWAY LAST TUESDAY NIGHT, DECEMBER 4.

RUTH WAS BORN IN CHAMPION, NEBRASKA, NEXT TO THE ELDEST OF TEN CHILDREN. HER PARENTS STILL FARM IN THAT LOCALE. RUTH WAS EDUCATED IN CHASE COUNTY SCHOOLS, ATTENDING SUMMER SCHOOL AT McCOOK JR COLLEGE FOLLOWING HER HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. LATER SHE ENROLLED IN NEBRASKA STATE COLLEGE AT KEARNEY. DURING HER 3 1/2 YEARS THERE SHE WAS A MEMBER OF "COLHECON" AND HELD THE COLLEGE SHOT-PUT RECORD FOR GIRLS. SHE WAS VERY ACTIVE IN ATHLETICS AND RECEIVED HER B.S. DEGREE IN EDUCATION THIS PAST JUNE.

BEFORE COMING TO ALASKA, RUTH HAD HELD SEVERAL STUDENT TEACHER POSITIONS. SHORTLY BEFORE COMING NORTHWARD IN AUGUST SHE BECAME ENGAGED TO CHARLES CARLSON WHO IS SERVING AS A CARPENTER INSTRUCTOR IN SOUSSE, TUNISIA. RUTH HAD PLANNED TO TEACH THIS SCHOOL TERM IN EAGLE RIVER AND RETURN TO NEBRASKA NEXT SUMMER. FROM THERE SHE PLANNED TO GO TO TUNISIA TO BE MARRIED.

DURING HER BRIEF RESIDENCY IN OUR COMMUNITY RUTH MADE MANY FRIENDS WHO WILL LONG AND FONDLY REMEMBER HER AND WE ARE SURE HER SIXTH GRADE STUDENTS WILL TREASURE THE WEEKS SHE SPENT WITH THEM.

FUNERAL SERVICES ARE TO BE HELD TODAY (FRI, DECEMBER 7) IN CHAMPION, NEBRASKA, WITH INTERMENT NEARBY.

THE SYMPATHIES OF THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY ARE WITH RUTH'S PARENTS, FAMILY, AND HER FIANCE DURING THIS TIME OF DEEP BEREAVEMENT.

THE CHUGIAK G.O.P.'S WILL ELECT A NEW COMMITTEEMAN TO REPLACE ALLAN TAFF WHO IS MOVING TO KENAI IN A FEW DAYS. THE GROUP WILL ALSO DISCUSS PARTY BUSINESS AND WHAT WISHES LOCAL REPUBLICANS DESIRE TO HAVE THEIR REPRESENTATIVES BRING BEFORE THE STATE LEGISLATURE.

ALL REPUBLICANS IN THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK AREA ARE URGED TO ATTEND THE CAUCUS MEETING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE VOTING PRECINCT.

Moving Along

PROGRESS IS CONTINUING IN ERECTION OF THE FIRST LOCAL CIVIL DEFENSE SHELTER BEING BUILT JUST NORTH OF THE CHUGIAK SCHOOL. THE QUONSET SHELTER WHICH IS TO BE BURIED IN A HILL, IS NOW IN PLACE AND READY FOR BRACING WORK. ACCORDING TO GENE BENITO, C.C.D.D. DIRECTOR, THE NECESSARY BRACING MATERIALS WILL BE BROUGHT IN TO THE SITE IN A FEW DAYS AND COMMUNITY WORK PARTIES WILL BE HELD TO GET THE QUONSET HUT BRACED INSIDE BEFORE IT IS COVERED WITH PROTECTIVE DIRT.

A SECOND C.D. QUONSET IS NOW READY TO BE MOVED INTO THE SITE. THIS QUONSET WILL BE SET A-TOP THE GROUND IN FRONT OF THE ONE THAT IS BEING BURIED IN THE HILL. ONCE THIS SECOND BUILDING IS PLACED AND READY FOR USE, CIVIL DEFENSE MEETINGS AND TRAINING CLASSES WILL BE HELD THERE.

THE C.C.D.D. (CHUGIAK CIVIL DEFENSE DISTRICT) STAFF ARE MEETING EVERY OTHER SATURDAY NIGHT TO PLAN THE CONTINUED PROGRESS OF OUR LOCAL CIVIL DEFENSE PROGRAM. TOMORROW NIGHT'S MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE FREER HOME IN EAGLE RIVER.

ALREADY IT IS OBVIOUS THAT FUNDS ARE GOING TO BE CONTINUALLY NECESSARY TO KEEP THIS CIVIL DEFENSE PROJECT PROGRESSING. THOUGH A GREAT DEAL OF MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE STATE C.D. DEPT, OTHER NECESSITIES (LIKE BUILDING MATERIALS, FUEL, ETC) WILL HAVE TO BE PAID FOR BY RESIDENTS OF THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK LOCALE. OUR LOCAL G.D. STAFF (NEXT COLUMN)

IS ASKING FOR MONTHLY PLEDGES FROM EVERY FAMILY IN THE COMMUNITY SO THAT A WORKING FUND CAN BE AVAILABLE WHENEVER IT IS NECESSARY TO PURCHASE ANY MATERIALS TO CONTINUE ERECTING SHELTERS AND OTHER CIVIL DEFENSE CENTERS THROUGHOUT THE AREA. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS COLLECTED AT THE FIRST PUBLIC MEETING IN OCTOBER HAVE NOT YET BEEN EXPIRED, BUT BY THE TIME WORD FOR BRACING THE QUONSET NEXT TO THE CHUGIAK SCHOOL IS PURCHASED, THERE WILL BE NO MONIES LEFT. IT IS THE HOPE OF OUR CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR THAT THESE REGULAR MONTHLY PLEDGES WILL BE RECEIVED ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS AND THAT EACH FAMILY WILL OBLIGATE THEMSELVES WILLINGLY TO CONTRIBUTE \$2 - \$3 MONTHLY SO ADEQUATE SHELTERS CAN BE ERECTED IN SEVERAL LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE AREA TO HOUSE THE FOOD, MEDICAL AND OTHER SUPPLIES THAT THE STATE C.D. WILL PROVIDE.

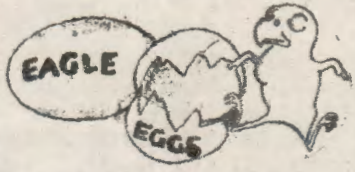

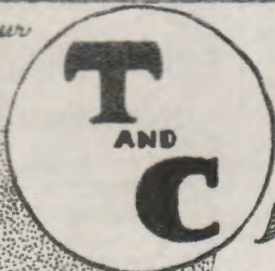

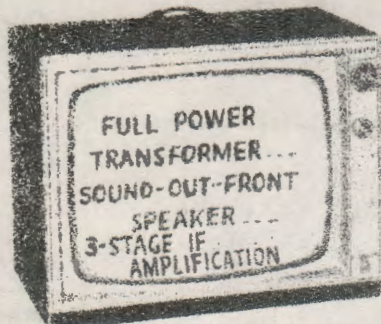
