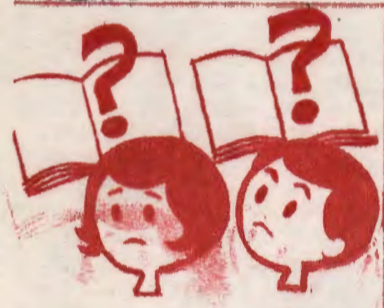

School Time

SCHOOL RESUMES FOR EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK STUDENTS AND OTHER ALASKAN PUPILS THROUGHOUT THE STATE NEXT TUES, SEPT 4TH.

ACCORDING TO SUPT CHUCK SMITH EAGLE RIVER SCHOOL WILL BE ON SHIFT. SHIFT #1 WILL ATTEND FROM 7:55 TILL 12:25, AND SHIFT #2 FROM 12:35 TILL 5:05. SHIFT #1 WILL INCLUDE STUDENTS LIVING WITHIN THE MILE AND ONE-HALF LIMIT (OR WALKING STUDENTS) WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THOSE STUDENTS LIVING IN THE EAGLE RIVER TRAILER COURT AND ON THE EAGLE RIVER HOMESTEAD ROAD. SHIFT #2 WILL INCLUDE ALL BUS STUDENTS PLUS STUDENTS IN THE EAGLE RIVER TRAILER COURT AND STUDENTS LIVING ON THE EAGLE RIVER HOMESTEAD ROAD. THE MILE AND ONE-HALF LINE TO THE NORTH IS THE DEBORA SUBDIVISION. STUDENTS LIVING THERE AND NORTH OF THIS AREA ARE BUS STUDENTS.

STARTING WEDNESDAY, THE BUS FOR SHIFT #2 AT
(CONTINUED NEXT COLUMN)

EAGLE RIVER WILL LEAVE THE BIRCHWOOD LOOP ROAD AND THE FAR END OF THE EAGLE RIVER HOMESTEAD ROAD AT 12:05. BUSES WILL LEAVE FOR THE CHUGIAK SCHOOL AT 8:30 DAILY. THE SCHEDULE AFTER THE FIRST DAY FOR THE CHUGIAK SCHOOL WILL BE:
GRADES 1 THRU 3, 9:00 TILL 2:30 P.M.
GRADES 4 THRU 8, 9:00 TILL 3:30 P.M.

THE DIVISION LINE BETWEEN THE TWO SCHOOLS IS THE SOUTH END OF THE BIRCHWOOD LOOP ROAD. ALL STUDENTS LIVING ON THE BIRCHWOOD LOOP ROAD AND TO THE NORTH WILL ATTEND CHUGIAK: TO THE SOUTH, EAGLE RIVER.

FIRST DAY SCHEDULE: CHUGIAK STUDENTS WILL ATTEND FROM 9:00 TILL 11:00. BUSES WILL LEAVE FROM THEIR MOST DISTANT POINTS AT 8:30. SHIFT #1 AT EAGLE RIVER WILL ATTEND FROM 10:00 TILL 12:00. SHIFT #2 WILL ATTEND FROM 1:00 TILL 3:00, WITH BUSES LEAVING THE BIRCHWOOD LOOP ROAD AND THE END OF THE EAGLE RIVER HOMESTEAD ROAD AT 12:30.

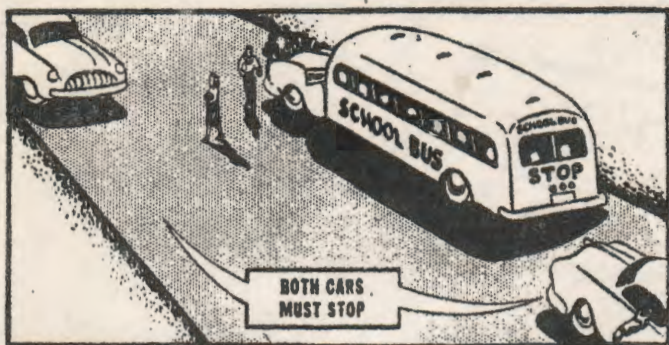

JUST \$50 MORE IS NEEDED NOW TO PAY FOR THE 1954 CADILLAC AMBULANCE & WE CAN PROUDLY SAY THAT EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK TEEN-AGERS HAVE BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING IN THE MOST OF THIS MONEY. IT HAS TAKEN SEVERAL WEEKS TO COLLECT THIS AMOUNT & WE SINCERELY HOPE THE REMAINING \$50 WILL SOON BE DONATED TO THE AMBULANCE CAN BELONG TO THE CHUGIAK VOLUNTEER FIRE CO FOR USE THROUGHOUT THIS AREA.

Dishwashers

There's a lot that's new about this year's electric dishwashers, but it takes more than a look to learn what it is.

On the surface, the 1962 electric dishwashers seem much the same as last year's, except for a few style changes. It's inside, where the work is done, that most of the changes have been made. The most important one is the improved washing action in medium and lower priced models as well as in deluxe units.

Powerful jets of hot water striking dishes from every direction scrub off even resistant foods such as egg and potato that used to require hand washing, or at least hand rinsing. This is accounted for by changes such as new impeller designs and, in some models, two or three different water jet sources.

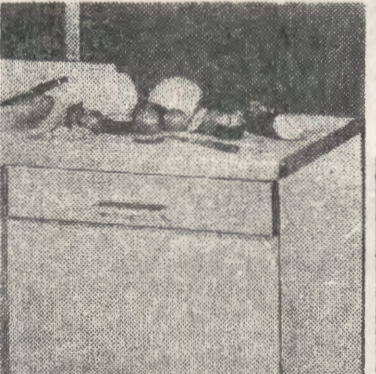
Since very hot water is important to the proper cleansing of dishes, more of the new automatic dishwashers have heating units that maintain the water temperature throughout all washing and rinsing phases. Some automatically bring temperature of the water up to 140 degrees if it drops below.

New rack designs make today's electric dishwashers easy to load. Some rack sections fold back to give a variety of placement patterns, and "random loading" can now be done without lessening the efficiency of the washing action.

The new automatic dishwashers also offer a greater choice of cycles for various types of loads. Many of them, for instance, have a heavy-duty cycle for pots and pans and a gentle one for glassware, as well as the usual washes and rinses.

If breakfast and lunch dishes are held in the dishwasher to be done after dinner, the rinse-and-hold cycle found on many of the 1962 models keeps food from sticking stubbornly. This is another factor that has helped eliminate hand rinsing.

Whatever its size or type, an electric dishwasher is more of a work-saver than ever. The homemaker who has a 1962 model can completely eliminate hand rinsing as well as the
