CHAPTER 9

Curtew

IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAP-TER 86, SECTION I OF THE 1962 SESSION LAWS OF ALASKA, THE MUNICIPAL CURFEW IS EXTENDED FOR A DISTANCE OF 2C MILES CUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF THE NEAREST MUNICIPALITY,

IN THE EAGLE RIVER CHUGIAK AREA THIS MEANS THAT
THE CURFEW LAWS ADOPTED BY
THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE EXTEND
NORTHWARD TO APPROXIMATELY
THE EKLUTNA BRIDGE.

ACCORDING TO THE SAID
STATUTE, STATE POLICE ARE
REQUIRED TO ENFORCE THE CURFEW. THE WEEK-DAY & SUNDAY
CURFEW TIME FOR YOUNG PEOPLE
UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IS 9:30PM
AND ON FRI & SAT NIGHTS THE
CURFEW TIME IS IC PM. THIS
LAW SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE
ATTENTION OF ALL PARENTS &
YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER 18 YEARS
OF AGE WHO RESIDE IN THE EAGLE
RIVER — CHUGIAK LOCALE.

Move the Capital

A GROUP OF REPUBLICANS
& DEMOCRATS WHO SHARE THE JOINT
INTEREST OF HAVING ALASKA'S
STATE CAPITAL MOVED FROM JUNEAU
TO A MORE ACCESSIBLE LOCALE
MET AT FIRE LAKE LODGE LAST
THURS NIGHT, SEPT 20TH. THREE
HUNDRED DOLLARS WAS REPORTED LY
COLLECTED TO PROMOTE THE "MOVE

IN THE CAPITAL CITY ITSELF
PROPERTY OWNERS ARE SEING
"TAXED" TO HELP FINANCE THE
CAMPAIGN OF ALASKANS UNITED TO
KEEP THE STATE CAPITAL FROM
SEING MOVED. JUNEAU CITY
COUNCIL VOTED TO SEND OUT "TAX
BILLS" (OF A VOLUNTARY NATURE)
REQUESTING A ONE-MILL TAX ON
ASSESSED VALUATIONS OF REAL

& PERSONAL PROPERTY. THE ANTI-CAPITAL-MOVE ORGANIZA-TION HAS ALSO REQUESTED THE CITY OF BOUGLAS & THE JUNEAU DOUGLAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DIST TO TAKE SIMILAR AGTION. THE ORGANIZATION FURTHER PLANS TO ASK NON-PROPERTY OWNERS TO CONTRIBUTE THE EQUIVALENT OF 2 HOURS PAY TO THE KEEP-THE-CAPITAL-IN-JUNEAU FUND.





JUST A FEW FEET BEYOND THE WHITE HIGHWAY CROSS WALK, THE DRIVERS EYES ARE ATTRACTED TO THE 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT SIGN POST.
