Curfew

IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 86, SECTION 1 OF THE 1962 SESSION LAWS OF ALASKA, THE MUNICIPAL CURFEW IS EXTENDED FOR A DISTANCE OF 20 MILES OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF THE NEAREST MUNICIPALITY.

IN THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK AREA THIS MEANS THAT THE CURFEW LAWS ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE EXTEND NORTHWARD TO APPROXIMATELY THE EKLVNA BRIDGE.

ACCORDING TO THE SAID STATUTE, STATE POLICE ARE REQUIRED TO ENFORCE THE CURFEW. THE WEEK-DAY & SUNDAY CURFEW TIME FOR YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IS 9:30 PM AND ON FRI & SAT NIGHTS THE CURFEW TIME IS 10 PM. THIS LAW SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL PARENTS & YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE WHO RESIDE IN THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK LOCALE.

Move the Capital

A GROUP OF REPUBLICANS & DEMOCRATS WHO SHARE THE JOINT INTEREST OF HAVING ALASKA'S STATE CAPITAL MOVED FROM JUNEAU TO A MORE ACCESSIBLE LOCALE MET AT FIRE LAKE LODGE LAST THURS NIGHT, SEPT 20TH. THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS WAS REPORTEDLY COLLECTED TO PROMOTE THE "MOVE THE CAPITAL" CAMPAIGN & DOOR-TO-DOOR CALLS IN THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK AREA ARE PLANNED TO RAISE AN ADDITIONAL \$200 TO REACH A \$500 GOAL FROM THIS LOCALE.

IN ANCHORAGE THE "CAPITAL INFORMATION CENTER" HAS BEEN OPENED AT THE LOG CABIN WHERE INTERESTED VOTERS MAY OBTAIN INFO ON THIS ISSUE.

IN THE CAPITAL CITY ITSELF PROPERTY OWNERS ARE BEING "TAXED" TO HELP FINANCE THE CAMPAIGN OF ALASKANS UNITED TO KEEP THE STATE CAPITAL FROM BEING MOVED. JUNEAU CITY COUNCIL VOTED TO SEND OUT "TAX BILLS" (OF A VOLUNTARY NATURE) REQUESTING A ONE-MILL TAX ON ASSESSED VALUATIONS OF REAL

& PERSONAL PROPERTY. THE ANTI-CAPITAL-MOVE ORGANIZATION HAS ALSO REQUESTED THE CITY OF DOUGLAS & THE JUNEAU-DOUGLAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DIST TO TAKE SIMILAR ACTION. THE ORGANIZATION FURTHER PLANS TO ASK NON-PROPERTY OWNERS TO CONTRIBUTE THE EQUIVALENT OF 2 HOURS PAY TO THE KEEP-THE-CAPITAL-IN-JUNEAU FUND.

THIS ISSUE HAS BEEN DEFEATED WHEN BROUGHT BEFORE ALASKAN VOTERS IN THE PAST, BUT MANY PERSONS OF BOTH THE GOP & DEMO PARTIES FEEL THAT RELOCATING THE CAPITAL WOULD BE THE "BEST MOVE" IN THE INTEREST OF ALASKA'S FUTURE GROWTH & DEVELOPMENT. THE PRO'S & CON'S ARE MANY WITH THOSE FAVORING THE "MOVE" OF THE OPINION THAT A STATE'S CAPITAL SHOULD BE MORE CENTRALLY LOCATED, MORE ACCESSIBLE BY EVERY MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION (AIR, RAIL, BUS, AUTO, ETC.) & THUS NOT BE THE RATHER EXPENSIVE TRIP IT IS NOW FOR PERSONS WHO MUST "FLY" TO THE CAPITAL CITY ON ANY IMPORTANT BUSINESS.

IF YOU ARE ONE OF THE EAGLE RIVER - CHUGIAK VOTERS WHO FEELS THAT RELOCATING THE STATE CAPITAL IS "THE BEST", THEN PLEASE MAKE WHATEVER CONTRIBUTION YOU ARE ABLE WHEN THE "MOVE-THE-CAPITAL" PERSONS CALL AT YOUR HOUSE.

THE CHARGE WILL BE \$250 PER FIRE CALL TO PERSONS WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE EAGLE RIVER IMPROVEMENT ASS'N OR WHO DO NOT SUBSCRIBE FOR FIRE PROTECTION (\$25 PER YEAR) FROM THE EAGLE RIVER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPT.



DURING A RECENT INSPECTION & INVENTORY OF CIVIL DEFENSE FIRE EQUIPMENT AT THE CHUGIAK VOLUNTEER FIRE CO, BY DON LOWELL, STATE C.D. DIRECTOR, IT WAS FOUND IN DIRE NEED OF ESSENTIAL FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT & REPAIRS WERE IN ORDER AS WELL AS MONEY FOR FUEL OIL & POWER

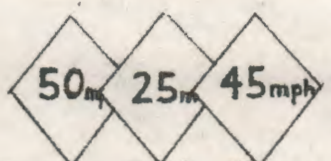

JUST A FEW FEET BEYOND THE WHITE HIGHWAY CROSS WALK, THE DRIVERS EYES ARE ATTRACTED TO THE 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT SIGN POST. THESE "CLOSELY POSTED" SIGNS, FROM ALL APPEARANCES, TEND TO ENCOURAGE THE DRIVER TO "STEP ON THE GAS" BEFORE HE HAS DRIVEN ACROSS THE SAFETY CROSS-WALK PAINTED ON THE PAVEMENT, BUT IN THE MEANTIME, HE NEVER HAS DROPPED HIS SPEED TO 25 MPH.

PERHAPS IF A LESSER SPEED LIMIT WERE POSTED FOR SOUTHBOUND (GOING TOWARDS ANCHORAGE) TRAFFIC DOWN AROUND MI 14 1/2, MOTDRISTS WOULD BE SLOWED DOWN TO 35 MPH AS THEY DRIVE PAST THE EAGLE RIVER SHOPPING CENTER (WHICH IS DEFINITELY A "BUSY" LOCALE WITH CARS PULLING IN & OUT OF THE PARKING AREA) AND BY THE TIME THEY REACHED THE 25 MPH SCHOOL ZONE THEY'D PERHAPS PASS AT THAT SPEED & NOT 5-10-15 OR 20 MILES ABOVE THAT LIMIT. ALSO, IF THE 50 MPH SIGN POST IN FRONT OF FAR NORTH WERE MOVED A FEW MORE YARDS "DOWN THE ROAD" TO BE OPPOSITE THE 25 MPH SIGN POSTED FOR NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC, THIS MIGHT ALSO DECREASE THE ACCELERATION ON THE GAS PEDAL TILL AFTER A CAR HAD SAFELY PASSED THE WIDE, WHITE, CROSS-WALK.

AS A FURTHER SAFETY PRECAUTION, PERHAPS IF OTHER PARENTS ALSO FEEL IT DESIRABLE, LARGE WHITE LETTERS COULD BE PRINTED ON THE PAVEMENT IN EACH LANE OF TRAFFIC TO ADD ANOTHER "OUNCE OF PREVENTION" TO THE SAFETY OF OUR SCHOOL CHILDREN.
